
**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO AUTHORIZE PAYMENT OF
SALARY AND BENEFITS TO PRESIDENT, LAWRENCE D. FORD II**

This Chapter 11 case is before the Court upon the debtor's motion to authorize payment of salary and benefits to its president, Lawrence D. Ford II [Docket No. 24]. A hearing on the motion was held March 22, 2007. Upon the evidence presented, it is ORDERED:

1. The motion is granted.
2. Debtor is authorized to pay a gross salary of \$2,307.69 per week to Mr. Ford during the pendency of this case.
2. Debtor is further authorized to continue providing health insurance benefits to Mr. Ford in the same manner as that provided pre-petition, the current payment being approximately \$840 per month.
3. Debtor is authorized to reimburse Mr. Ford for up to \$500 in expenses per month incurred by him in the ordinary course of conducting business for Heritage. Reimbursement is conditioned upon Mr. Ford providing receipts for said expenses, copies of which will be attached to the monthly operating reports or periodically furnished to the U.S. Trustee's office.

4. Mr. Ford shall be entitled to draw salary or receive other benefits only if the Debtor's post-petition obligations are being timely paid and funds remain available. Unpaid salary or benefits shall not accrue or be entitled to administrative expense priority.
